Accessing Google Classroom (in Hwb) using the app

Using the app:

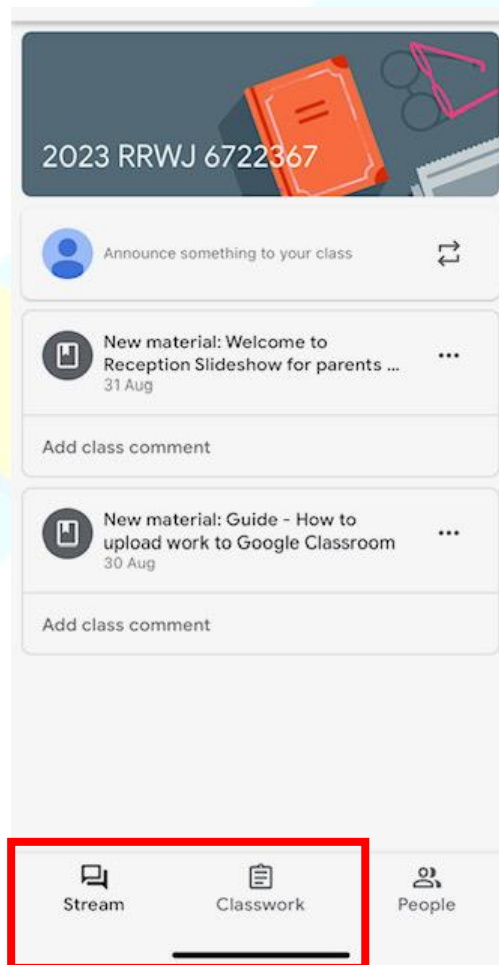
Download the Google Classroom app from the app/play store.

Google will request your child's Hwb e-mail address.

Then you will need to log in with Hwb log in/e-mail and then enter your password.

You should then see a classroom with your child's class teacher/year group name.

Click on the classroom and you will see the view below:



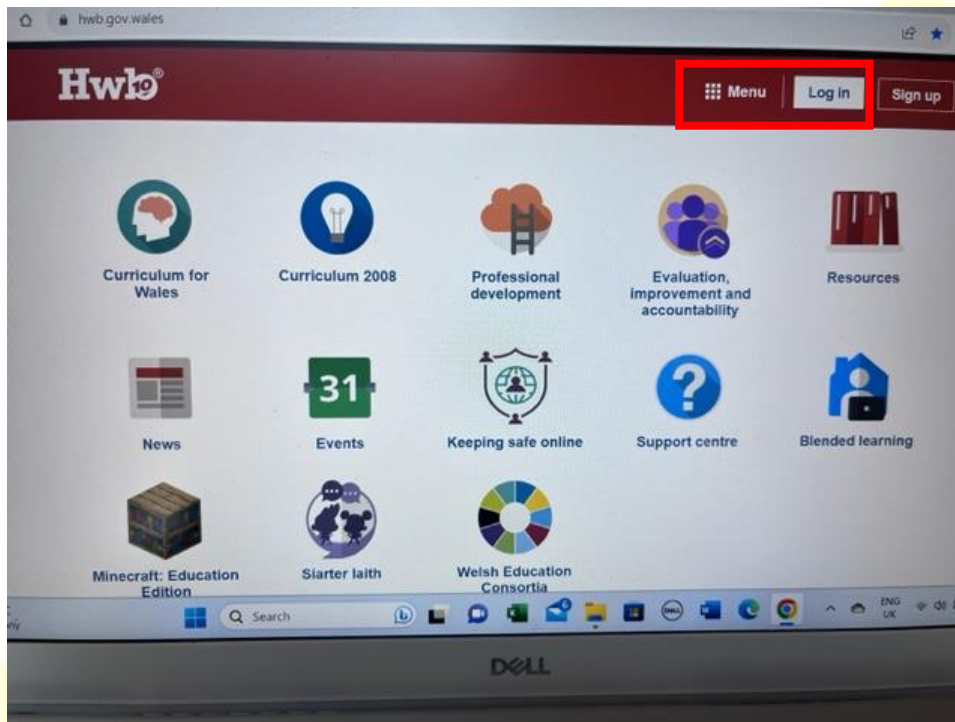
The stream/classwork tabs are at the bottom of your view.

Accessing Google Classroom (in Hwb) via an Internet Browser

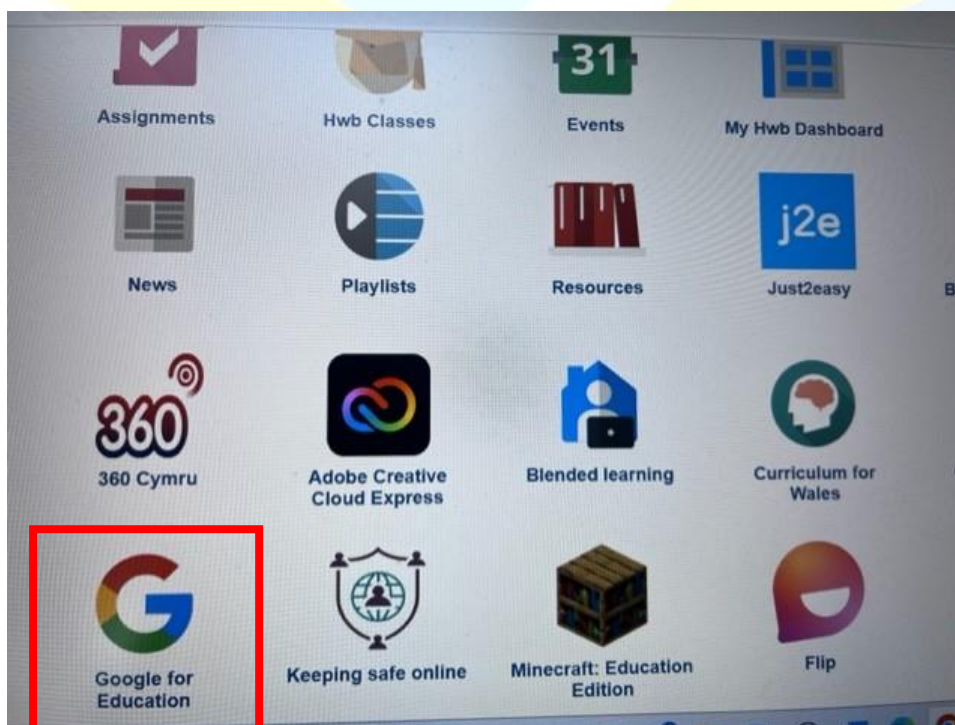
Reminder:

You need the instructions below to make sure you get into your child's Google Classroom.

1. Log in to Hwb using their Hwb log in (name@hwbcymru.net)

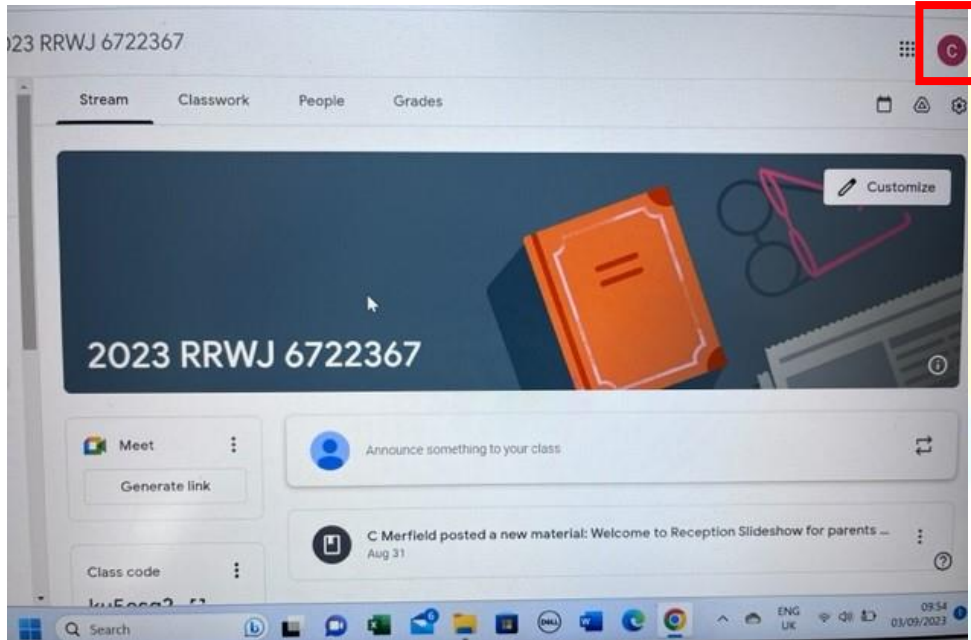


2. Click on the menu 'waffle' and click on the 'Google for Education' tab



When you get to the Google page, it may ask you to log in again.

- a. If it does, log in again using your child's Hwb log in details when it asks you to. It will redirect you to the Hwb log in page and ask you to log in again. You should then find yourself in their new Google Classroom like the one below.



- b. If you are logged in automatically, check the button on the right-hand side of the screen (in red box above). When you hover over this, it will show you the account you are logged in with.
- c. Google will remember all accounts on the device but will always default to one of them. If you have more than one Google account on your device (e.g. personal Google accounts or other family members' accounts) just check that you are in the right account when trying to access your child's new Google Classroom.
