Eisteddfod – Monday 2nd March

World Book Day – Thursday 5th March

All children are invited to bring a favourite book and wear a costume to school. All classes will be taking part in a variety of book themed activities throughout the day.

Parent Consultations

Our Spring parent consultation meetings will be on Monday 16th and Wednesday 18th March. The teachers will have the children's books and digital work available for you to see.

The booking system will be online as per the Autumn term. You can access the booking through the '[parents' menu on our website](#)', logging in with the same email address that you have registered with the school. **The bookings will close on Wednesday 11th March, after which, no further changes can be made.** This is so that teachers can prepare for the following week.

Please arrive via the main office. Nursery and Mrs Veasey's Reception class will both have some afternoon time slots *during* the school day. For these slots, the office staff will direct you to the meeting place when you arrive.

IMPORTANT - To confirm the reservation, click on the SAVE button in the bottom right corner. The slot will only be reserved for 10 minutes and will be released again if the booking is not saved.

Personalised Assessments

All pupils from Years 2 – 6 have now completed their personalised assessments in Numeracy and Reading. The individual 'learner feedback' is now available by logging into your child's Hwb account.

This feedback provides some indicators about skills and knowledge areas where each learner has performed particularly well as well as likely areas where they may need further support. We cannot view the actual questions / answers, so that sort of specific feedback isn't possible.
