Re. Sports Day – Wednesday 12th June

Dear parents/carers,

We are pleased to invite you to this year's sports day on Wednesday 12th June.

Timings are as follows:

Nursery to Year 3: 9.15 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. (NOTE – YEAR 3 IN THE MORNING)
Years 4 – 6: 1.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m.

Please could parents note the following points:

- All children to **wear their PE kit to school** on the day as there will be no time for them to change. If possible, please can your child wear their house colours in some way (teachers will inform them of these).
- **Bring a water bottle**
- Weather depending, please help them to **apply sun cream before coming to school and a hat** may also be advisable if it is a sunny day. (Please ensure hats are named)

The races will take place on the school field as usual and families will need to enter and leave the school via the main gate entrance. If coming by car, please can I urge that everyone is respectful of access to our neighbours properties (and our staff entrance). Also, please do not block or use the rear deliveries areas for the shops as we routinely receive complaints about this each year.

For safeguarding / safety purposes, there will be barriers placed in front of the running area so please can I ask all supporters to respect these arrangements – to remain behind the barriers and not to move or open barriers in order to get their own 'preferred' spot at either end of the track. Similarly, I need to ask for your co-operation when we bring the children to or from the school. I do appreciate that some supporters may just want to say a quick "hi" to their child, but the teachers do need to ensure that they have all their children with them as they arrive and leave which gets very challenging with hundreds of children and adults around.

In the event of inclement weather, our 'reserve' date for sports day is Thursday 20th June and timings will be the same.

We look forward to seeing you on the day and hope to make it an enjoyable and memorable experience for everyone.
